2009 AMATSU TATARA SPIRITUAL SEMINAR WITH 58th GENERATION GRANDMASTER TANEMURA SENSEI

In August of this year a rare and unique seminar will take place in Trim, County Meath. The 1st ever Amatsu Tatara Seminar will be taught by Grandmaster Shoto Tanemura from Japan.



Grandmaster Tanemura, or 'Tanemura Sensei', is the only Grandmaster of a direct lineage of Grandmasters who carried ancient knowledge throughout the ages. Grandmaster Tanemura is the 58th Generation Grandmaster of the Amatsu Tatara. He is the sole carrier of these ancient Amatsu Tatara teachings which stretch back 2700 years in recorded history, but whose source is much older. Teachings have been passed directly from grandmaster to grandmaster and in any generation there is only one Grandmaster. So it is an honour for the people of Ireland that such a person will come here to share this knowledge.



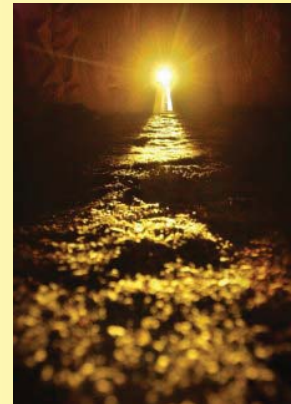
For most of his life, Grandmaster Tanemura has been renowned all over the world for his martial art teachings. Holding Grandmasterships in over 20 ryu ha (martial traditions), he is unique even among Grandmasters. He is already an historical figure. However, over the last 10 years Grandmaster Tanemura has begun to share the Amatsu Tatara knowledge with his students.

In Japan, some scholars, priests and martial artists are aware of the existence of Amatsu Tatara teachings. Historically, the Amatsu Tatara was highly secretive as it was only meant for a special grandmaster or special priest. However, as the only authority on the Amatsu Tatara in the world, Grandmaster Tanemura insists that the time has now come for this knowledge to be shared in the world.



In essence the Amatsu Tatara is the ancient teachings of Heaven and Nature. Within the teachings lie knowledge and techniques that can enable human beings to understand their own nature within the cycle of life. The main purpose of this knowledge is for people to be able to find happiness in their lives and to try to build as good a world as possible, for everyone.

The Amatsu Tatara contains knowledge about healing and health. Importantly, how to maintain a balanced relationship between body and spirit/mind. Techniques include both physical methods, such as massage and special healing points, and also non-physical methods; for example, how to heal a damaged spirit/mind. To understand health on a deeper level, one must have an understanding of the meaning and reason for life itself.



Thesedays there are many new age healing systems in the world. The Amatsu Tatara is not new age. Instead it is ancient knowledge whose source originates beyond ancient Egypt and Sumeria to truly ancient times. Many new age systems are just one persons idea and limited to a single persons experience. On the other hand, the Amatsu Tatara is the knowledge of many special people over thousands of years, preserved carefully through the lineage of Grandmasters. Occasionally some people try to associate themselves to the Amatsu Tatara by using its name, or part of its name, but there is only one source of this special knowledge in the world: Grandmaster Tanemura Sensei. He would like now to show everyone what the true Amatsu Tatara teachings are.



The Grandmaster has come to Ireland many times over the last 10 years. Some of Ireland's ancient places, such as Tara and Newgrange etc, are deeply connected to the Amatsu Tatara tradition. Some of the symbols found at these places are known and already exist within Amatsu Tatara knowledge. Because of this, the historic Japanese Grandmaster has a special affinity for Ireland. He has chosen Ireland as the location to hold the 1st ever Amatsu Tatara Seminar.

From those of us who are familiar with Grandmaster Tanemura, we assure you that his depth of knowledge is rare and very special. Such an opportunity may not come again in our lifetimes. We recommend that you take this golden opportunity to learn directly from such a source of ancient wisdom. As is said in Japan: 'I Shin den Shin', i.e. direct learning from heart to heart. There is no substitute for the direct transmission of knowledge from the teacher's heart to the receiver's heart.
